She parlayed a graduate school internship with Suntory Water Group (now D.S. Services) into a consulting and then full-time developer role. She excelled and managed the Data Services team before leaving for the Atlanta Housing Authority (AHA) in 1997.

Kim has worn many hats in her 10 years with AHA; from developer, to development team manager, Scrum Master, and solutions architect. For her efforts, she was named Employee of the Month in 2012 and later received the Iron Man award for innovation.
